TITLE OF POSITION: English Teacher

- Teach four classes per semester (full-time load).

- Participate in departmental and school-wide professional development initiatives (examples: curriculum mapping, technology training, Ignatian education workshops).
- Participate in the extracurricular life of the students and the school.
- Teach and lead students in accordance with Ignatian educational principles and the mission of Brebeuf Jesuit.
- Act as a personal example of those attributes to which we call our students (the “Grad at Grad”): open to growth, intellectually competent, loving, religious, and committed to promoting justice.

 - Bachelor’s Degree
 - Indiana Certification/Teaching License
 - Prior background in the study, practice, and/or teaching of the relevant literature
 - Sensitivity to diversity- values a diversity of perspectives, traditions, ideas, and contributions
- **PREFERRED**
 - Master’s degree in Education, English, or relevant/related field
 - Experience with education related technologies (Microsoft Office, GradeBook, etc.)
 - Prior experience in diverse working community
 - Prior experience in Jesuit education
