



Cristo Rey Network Fact Sheet

- Cristo Rey Network high schools provide a Catholic, college preparatory education to urban youth with limited resources through a rigorous academic curriculum and innovative corporate work study program
- Cristo Rey Network schools nationwide have grown from 4 in 2004 to 26 today
- 8,200 students nationwide
- 15,000 students will be enrolled in Cristo Rey Network schools by 2020
- 1,700 corporate work study jobs
- 1,800 companies nationwide employ Cristo Rey students as part of the work study program
- 100% of Cristo Rey graduates are accepted to college
- Cristo Rey schools employ a sustainable revenue model that does not rely solely on traditional fundraising or government funding and, therefore, can provide an affordable, quality educational option.
- Cristo Rey students are earning more than \$40mm through the Corporate Work Study Program (partnering with 1,800 companies nationwide). This revenue covers half of the students' education cost.
- According to the National Student Clearinghouse, Cristo Rey Network graduates are enrolling and completing college at twice the rate as their peers from the same socio economic background.
